

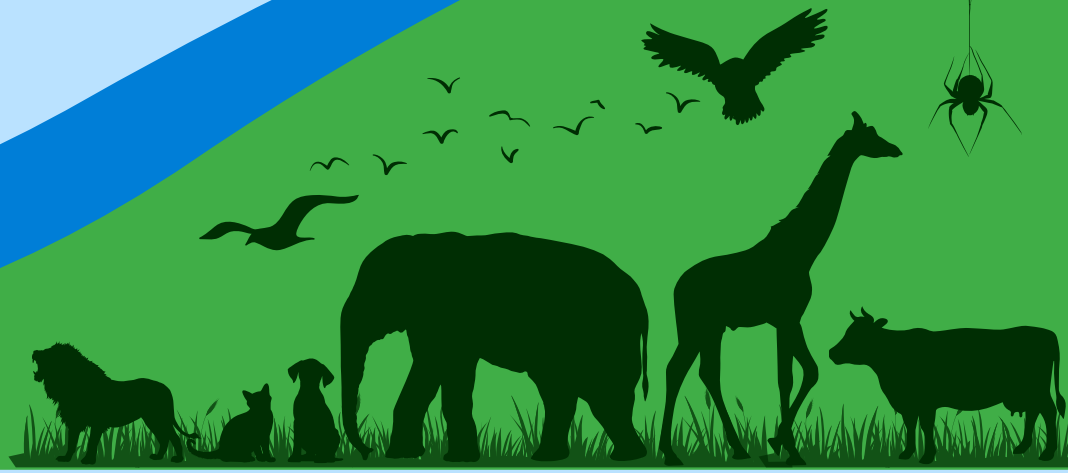
ZOOLOGY WEEKEND PROGRAMME

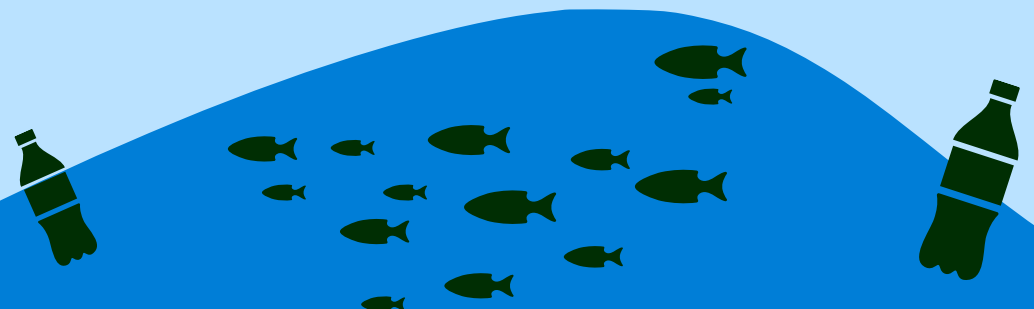
